MASON MAN SENTENCED FOR AGGRAVATED VEHICULAR HOMICIDE

Michael Tucker, a 45-year-old Mason man, pled guilty Tuesday and was sentenced on one count of Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, a felony of the first degree. Judge Neal Bronson sentenced Tucker to serve four years in prison (mandatory) and imposed a lifetime driver's license suspension.

On October 1, 2010, in Turtlecreek Township, Tucker was driving a vehicle with Leonard Anderson in the passenger seat. Tucker lost control of his motor vehicle on Brewer Road and crashed into a cement culvert. Anderson was pronounced dead at the scene.

Tucker's blood alcohol test results were .105. Tucker's blood also tested positive for cocaine. Tucker was operating his vehicle while under multiple driver's license suspensions.
