The Warren County Prosecutor's Office has been notified that a man who fled $6\frac{1}{2}$ years ago while a Warren County jury was deliberating his fate on several felony charges was arrested in Montgomery County this past weekend.

James Scott, Jr., 46, whose last known address was on West Pekin Road, Lebanon, was arrested during a traffic stop by officers from the Dayton Police Department. Scott had been on the loose since October 28, 2005, when he left the courthouse during jury deliberations and failed to return. The jury returned with findings of guilty to all charges, including seven counts of crack cocaine trafficking and two counts of cocaine possession.

Scott is being held in the Montgomery County Jail pending disposition of charges filed by the Dayton Police Department. Once he appears in Warren County for sentencing, Scott faces a maximum of 60 years in prison. No sentencing date has been set.
