A Dayton man who attempted to rob an ATM customer will serve the next 5 years behind bars.

Today William Jackson, 48, pled guilty to aggravated robbery and was sentenced to five years in prison by Judge James Flannery in the Warren County Court of Common Pleas.

The incident occurred on December 1, 2012, at the PNC Bank in Landen. Jackson approached the victim from behind and demanded she give him \$200 or he would hit her on the head with a hammer. The victim ran away and escaped unharmed. Jackson then fled in his vehicle, but crashed and was apprehended a short time later.
