Springboro High School Student Arrested, Charged with Making Bomb Threat

Earlier today, the Springboro Police Department arrested Springboro High School student Andrew Stadler for making a bomb threat that caused the evacuation of Springboro High School on Wednesday, April 27, 2016. Stadler, 18, has been charged with inducing panic, a second degree felony, and making false alarms, a fifth degree felony. As an adult, Stadler will be arraigned in Warren County Court at a time and date yet to be determined.

Springboro High School was evacuated on Wednesday, April 27, 2016, shortly before 1:00 p.m. based upon the discovery of a bomb threat Stadler is accused of writing on a restroom wall. The high school remained closed on Thursday, April 28, 2016, while the district conducted a more extensive search of the building. The threat also caused a district-wide cancelation of evening extra-curricular activities.

"I'm very grateful for the staff and students of the Springboro Community School District who were instrumental in providing information that helped identify the suspect, and the Springboro Police Department for all of their efforts in investigating this case," said Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell.
