

# Grand Jury Indicts Maintenance Worker for Burglary, Voyeurism

Warren County Prosecutor David P. Fornshell announced today a 15 count grand jury indictment against a local maintenance man. Gerald D. Rowe, 65, of Milford was indicted for nine counts of burglary (F3), five counts of voyeurism (M2), and one count of possession of criminal tools (F5).

Rowe worked as a maintenance worker at Steeplechase Apartments in Deerfield Township. During the period of February 2016 through May 2016, Rowe is charged with using his position as a maintenance worker to access the homes of four female residents of the apartment complex. While inside, Rowe is accused of installing video recording equipment in the females' restrooms to capture them in states of undress.

Some of the indicted charges may be merged for purposes of sentencing. However, if convicted, Rowe faces a maximum possible sentence of eight years in prison on each of the burglary counts, 60 days in jail on each of the voyeurism counts, and one year on the single count of possession of criminal tools.

Rowe is scheduled to be arraigned on August 26, 2016 at 8:30 a.m. in Warren County Common Pleas Court.
